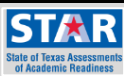

As mandated by the Texas Education Agency, students in Grades 3 through 12 are required to take part in the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR) program.

**STAAR Grades 3 - 8:** These exams assess math and reading at each grade level, science in grades 5 & 8 and social studies in grade 8.

**STAAR EOC:** These assessments test high school students for college readiness and produce performance labels that indicate a student's mastery of the course's standards. The end-of-course tests assess the students in Algebra I, Biology, English I & II and US History.

**STAAR-Alt 2 Grades 3-12:** This alternate assessment is based on alternate academic achievement standards and is designed for students with significant cognitive disabilities who meet the participation requirements. STAAR -Alt is administered in the same grades and subjects as STAAR.

**TELPAS Grades K-12 & TELPAS -ALT Grades 2-12:** This exam is designed to assess the progress that limited English proficient (LEP) students make in learning the English language. This assessment consists of online reading tests (for grades 2-12) and online listening & speaking and holistic rating of writing (for grades K-12).
