Re: Student Identification Badge System

For the 2024-2025 school year all students will be required to wear their identification badges at all times while on school premises, including after school activities and weekend events. The school district will provide the initial badge and one lanyard free of charge to each student. This measure has been implemented to enhance the security and well-being of every student within our school community.

Please note the following key points regarding the new identification badge system:

- 1. **Mandatory Badge Usage:** Students are required to wear their identification badges visibly at all times during school hours, after school activities and weekend events. The badges will be expected to be on a lanyard around the necks of the student. Putting badges on backpacks or other areas will not be acceptable.
- 2. **Disciplinary Action:** Failure to wear the identification badge may result in discipline action. We kindly request your support in ensuring that your child complies with this requirement for their safety and the safety of their peers.
- 3. **Lost or Damaged Badges:** In the event that a student loses or damages their identification badge, a replacement can be obtained for a nominal fee of \$5.00. This fee is intended to cover the cost of producing a new badge.

We understand that changes like these can sometimes be met with questions or concerns. However, we firmly believe that the implementation of this identification badge system will contribute to a more secure and protected learning environment for all students.
