 - Recommended swipe cards rather than keys for exterior doors
 - Area at WOHS near gym lockers; recommendation to add a camera to that area
 - Doors need to be removed that pose a fire hazard
 - Work will take place during the fall
 - Most doors will be repaired, rather than replaced
 - Board approved \$500,000 to be allocated for this purpose
