	MITIGATION
LEVEL	One or more confirmed case(s) of COVID-19 at one facility
2	<ul> <li>Persons who came within close contact of an individual with a confirmed case of COVID-19 will be personally contacted by health experts and advised to self-quarantine for 10 days. If a student is identified as a CLOSE CONTACT, then the parent/guardian will receive a PERSONAL CALL from Nursing or District Staff to discuss health information and protocols.</li> <li>Affected area is closed for deep cleaning.</li> <li>Self-screening of symptoms, prevention information and "stay home if ill" communication to all persons at the school or facility by campus administration using robocalls, robotexts and Remind App.</li> <li>A short-term closure of facility may be necessary for three days.</li> </ul>
	MODIFIED OPERATIONS
LEVEL	Three or more confirmed COVID-19 cases in one specific area (i.e. classroom)
	Students and staff of that area will be advised to self-quarantine for 10 days.
	Students impacted move to remote learning.
5	<ul> <li>Affected area is closed for deep cleaning.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Self-screening of symptoms, prevention information and stay home if ill reminders sent to all persons at the school or facility by campus administration using robocalls, robotexts and Remind App.</li> </ul>
	A short-term closure of facility may be necessary for three days.
	FACILITY CLOSURE
LEVEL	COVID-19 cases exceed 5% of facility occupancy
	Entire facility will be closed for a minimum of two days.
	All students and staff at this campus may return if symptom free upon
4	determination by the school district and health authorities.
	<ul> <li>Those in close contact of the confirmed COVID-19 positive persons will be asked to self- quarantine for 10 days per CDC guidelines.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>District-wide communication to staff/parents with health monitoring guidance by district administration using robocalls, robotexts and Remind App.</li> </ul>
	DISTRICT CLOSURE
LEVEL	
LLVLL	COVID-19 cases exceed 5% of occupancy in more than 1 facility
	All West Oso ISD facilities close for a minimum of 04 days.      Students and staff move to 1000/ remote learning and work.
5	<ul> <li>Students and staff move to 100% remote learning and work.</li> <li>Disinfection of all facilities and school buses.</li> </ul>
	All auxiliary areas such as playgrounds and athletic fields are closed.
	Extracurricular activities are cancelled.
