

# A Quick Reference for Parents

To help prevent children from acquiring contagious illnesses, please follow the district guidelines listed below. If a student returns to school before the recommended time, parents will be notified to pick up their child. A child <u>must leave school</u> if any of the following conditions occur:

### Diarrhea/Vomiting

Children should be without diarrhea or vomiting for **24 hours** before returning to school.

#### **Fever**

Children should be without fever (temperature less than 100 degrees without taking mediation) for <u>24 hours</u> before returning to school.

## Pink-Eye/Conjunctivitis

A child with conjunctivitis is highly contagious and should be kept at home until he/she has been seen by a physician and has

a **medical release** to return to school and has been on antibiotics for **24 hours**.

### **Strep Throat**

A child with strep throat is highly contagious and should be kept at home until he/she has been seen by a physician and has a **medical release** to return to school and has been on antibiotics and fever free for **24 hours** 



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
